- 1- writing tablet no larger than 5" x 8" (no wire bound or composition books)
- 1- ADULT toothbrush (individually factory-sealed, no multi-packs)
- 5- first-class #10 Stamp-Embossed Envelopes (from US Post Office - no regular stamps)
- 2- rolls of hard candy like LifeSavers, Mentos, Breath Savers (NO Smarties, Sweetarts, Necco Wafers, Rolos, Starburst, Tic-tac's)
- 1- 3.2 oz. to 6 oz. bar of soap (no travel size, no unwrapped/unboxed bars)
